


Women's Month

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The Dug Out results were as follows:

1st Place: Moonlight – Assorted sweet jars and packets

2nd Place: Khanyisa – Waters bottles and Earpods

3rd Place: Ultra Lux – Sunglasses, Scrunchies, Bonnets and Jewellery

With only a few weeks left in the 2023 YLED calendar, we are confident that the cohort will leave with an entrepreneurial attitude. After the big event, Dug Out, the companies started selling their products to the market.

Each week until liquidation are focused on the company's sales reports which covers what they have bought, how much money they have used, have they used their loan and the most important part, how much money have they made. These sessions teach the learners how to be accountable for every single thing that happens within the company as well as how to record business finances, improving sales strategy as well as managing their cash flow.

The Youth Entrepreneurship Program is coming to a close, with three mini-businesses still in operation: Khanyisa, Ultra-Lux, and Moonlight.

We held a successful Dug Out event in which the three companies had to propose their company concepts to a panel of judges in order to earn financing, with the expectation that they will be able to run their enterprises effectively within 8 weeks.

The 2022 African Bank Youth Development Programme (ABYDP25) has come to its completion.

We are excited to inform you that our Transform4Growth program with African Bank for unemployed youth will graduate 12 unemployed young people. Cohort, one of the YDP25 programmes, has come to completion.

Our YDP25 2023 cohort internship is still in progress and is scheduled to end on January 26th, 2024. So far, the cohort has participated in a new business formation training program from July 25th to August 29th, 2023.

We are working on the third cohort intake which will begin in January 2024.

We are excited to announce that we have reached the end of our 2023 Dimension Data Programme which consisted of 9 grade 11 sessions and 9 grade 12 bringing us to a total of 18 impactful sessions for the year 2023.


